

## AMTRON experts impart training to Sabha employees on book digitisation

A team of software technology experts from AMTRON led by senior official Manoj Kumar Barua imparted training to Sabha employees on various process of book digitisation at the Radhagovinda Barua hall in the Sabha's Guwahati office on December 28. It may be mentioned here that the Sabha has recently signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with AMTRON to implement the scheme of formation of a digital archive and also to ensure proper protection and preservation of a series of invaluable books by means of digitisation. According to the MoU, the AMTRON will provide the required infrastructure including manpower for reconstruction of such selected reading materials by means of OCR, DTP, scanning or any other suitable technology.

In the said training programme, the experts advised the Sabha employees to first select the books. After that the conditions of the books will be properly examined and accordingly the suitable method will be applied, the experts said. The experts also apprised the trainees of the cataloging, metadata creation, production schedule and other phases of book digitisation.

Software developer and a member of the Sabha's IT Sub-committee, Tridip Kumar Barua was also present on the occasion.
